

ASSESSMENT SERVICES FOR INTERNATIONALLY-TRAINED WORKERS

Project Synopsis

Time: >12 months

Complexity: High

Cost: >\$100,000

This project creates an assessment service for internationally-trained workers (ITWs) to expedite their registration process and support successful employment in regulated professions.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Assessing ITWs to become certified in regulated occupations can be challenging for regulators. Regulators can become overwhelmed by the number of ITW applications. This project creates a new fast-track assessment service for ITWs by developing assessment tools and processes to recognize competencies.

KEY OUTCOMES

- Regulators have a method to assess all qualified applicants.
- ITWs enjoy a fast and efficient assessment process.
- Employers can be confident that an ITW meets certification standards.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Create fast-track assessment services in collaboration with stakeholders to expedite the registration process.
- Develop consistency in decision making to address the respective needs of the many stakeholders involved.

PROJECT COMPONENT

- Development of competency-based assessment process and supporting tools, such as: educational database of international training institutions curricula, a website to improve communication with ITWs, and online application form.
