

# DEVELOPING ASSESSMENT DOCUMENTS FOR INTERNATIONALLY-TRAINED WORKERS

## Project Synopsis

Time: 3 – 6 months

Complexity: Medium

Cost: \$25,000 - \$100,000

This project creates registration materials and application documents specifically designed for internationally-trained workers (ITWs). This project assists a regulator that previously may not have been able to assess ITWs due to a lack of equivalency standards.

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Some regulators may not have identified the necessary criteria to evaluate an ITW's qualifications against a regulated occupation. This project researches and designs the assessment criteria for ITWs, including appropriate application documents that help demonstrate their qualifications regardless of country of origin.

## KEY OUTCOMES

- Regulators have a method to assess ITWs to practice in regulated occupations.
- ITWs have a process that is fair and uniform.
- ITWs can become certified to practice in regulated occupations.

## KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Develop a study guide to assist ITWs and other applicants to understand the assessment requirements and procedures.
- Ensure that proposed changes to the entry requirements for the profession will not conflict with any Mutual Recognition Agreements that has been signed by the regulatory bodies within Canada.

## PROJECT COMPONENT

- Design of assessment criteria documents for FQR applications.
