

# ONLINE PORTAL FOR REGISTRATION OF INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

## Project Synopsis

Time: >12 months

Complexity: Medium

Cost: >\$25,000 - \$100,000

This project develops a central website to house tools and materials to assist internationally-trained workers (ITWs) to register in a regulated occupation. This project also informs and prepares ITWs of the registration steps prior to immigrating to Canada.

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

To improve the efficiency of a certification process, this project designs an online portal that directs an ITW to the next step in their registration process. The online tool conducts competency gap analysis to inform and prepare ITWs of the registration steps prior to immigrating to Canada. The content also includes videos that simulate the entire registration process and interviews to provide insights in building successful careers.

### KEY OUTCOMES

- ITWs can demonstrate competencies before arriving to Canada, ensuring they spend less time applying to become certified.
- Regulators do not have to respond to individual queries about the certification process.

### KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Build a pre-assessment readiness tools such as Competency Self-Assessment prior to building the online portal.
- Use clear language in the interviews to map out and simulate the whole registration process.

### PROJECT COMPONENT

- Design of an information technology tool to automate the collection and analysis of interview results to help in the certification process.
