

Note: This map describes the different paths to take to become a home inspector in British Columbia (B.C.). It is intended to be read along with the Job Profile and Quiz Results. The path you must take depends on the type of training/education and work-related experience you currently have in this occupation. Please ensure that all the documents you submit are in English. The approximate time it will take to go through this path ranges from 12 months to 15 months. This timeframe will vary depending on how quickly you complete the application form(s), write the exams, and take any required courses. The cost of qualification ranges from \$6,700 to \$11,500. The fees listed may include tax. None of the fees include the cost of post-secondary education.
